

Hector's Being Selfish

Overview: Being a good friend is a recurring theme for the "Can Do" Kids. Someone took Willie's and Nellie's lunches and now they have nothing to eat. All the "Can Do" Kids are sharing part of their lunches except Hector. In this program the children help Hector realize that friends help their friends and that it's important to do the right thing.

Activity 1: Sharing lunch with a friend who didn't have lunch is the theme of this activity. It asks the child doing the activity to examine his or her feelings about sharing. It also asks what he or she would tell Hector about sharing and why it is important to share.

Activity 2: Being a friend means sharing. This activity asks what makes a good friend and why. It also asks the children doing the activity to write about when they helped a friend and when a friend helped them.

Activity 3: Sharing can be a hard thing to do especially when it means sharing food you really enjoy. This activity asks children to talk about what they find hard about sharing. There is a maze that adds an element of fun to the questions and an opportunity to draw two things that are good to share.
